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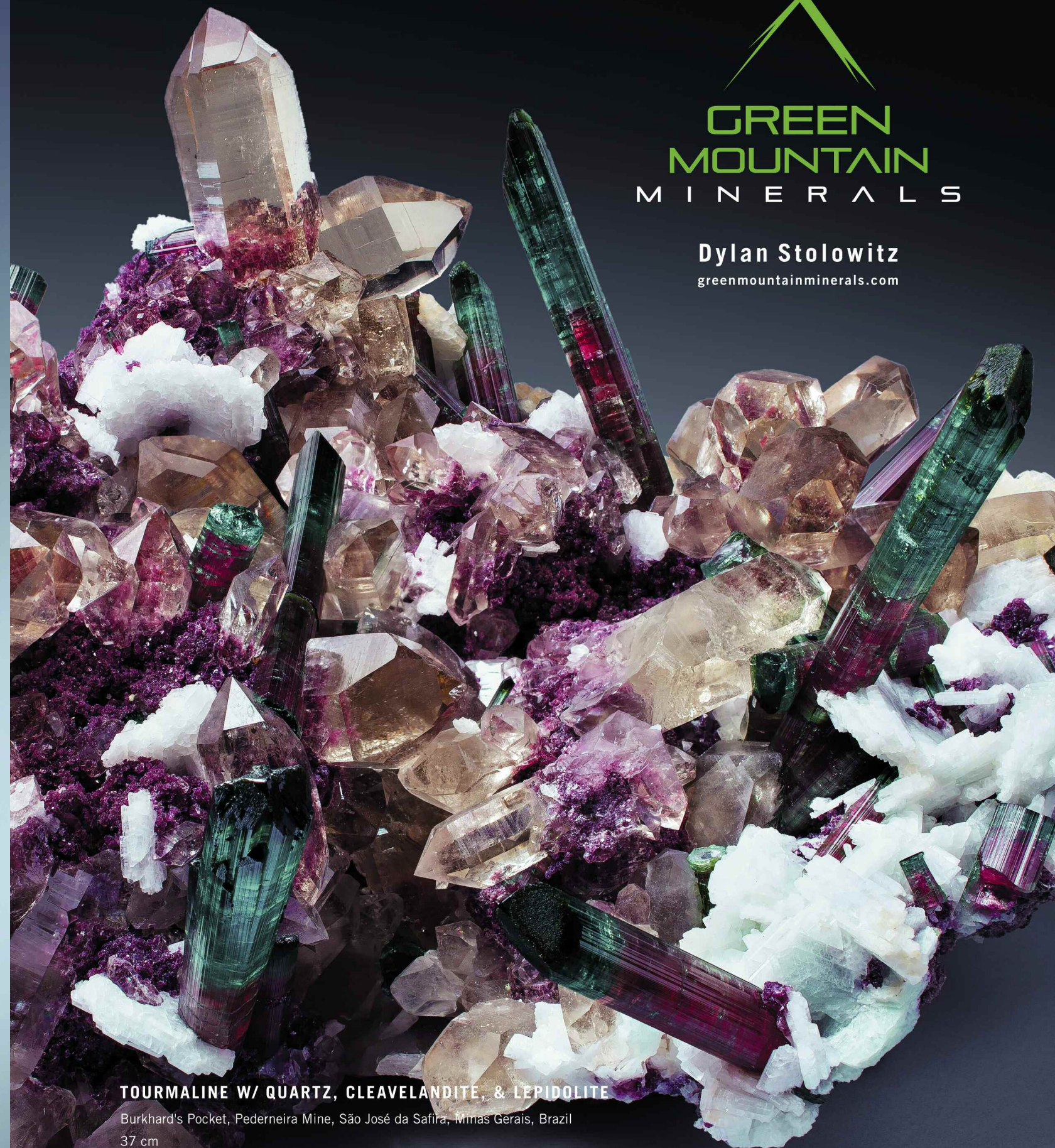

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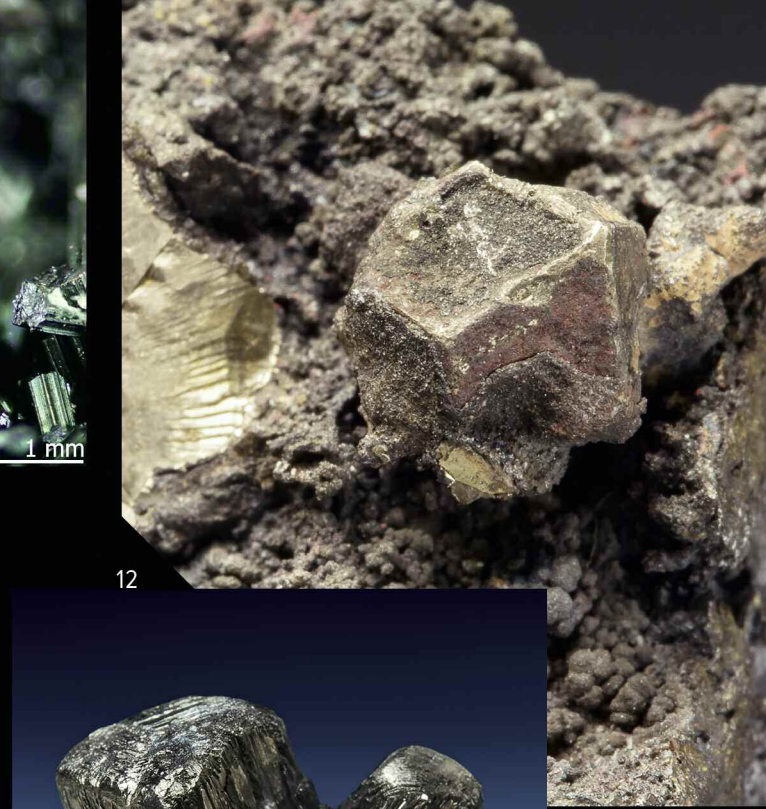
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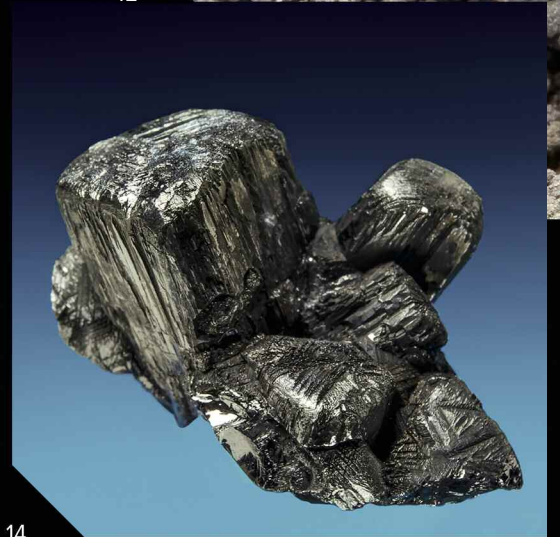

It is fitting that we call this the «silver wave» for two reasons: it looks like a wave and waves from Lake Superior constantly flooded the mine until they forced abandonment in 1884 after 14 bonanza years.

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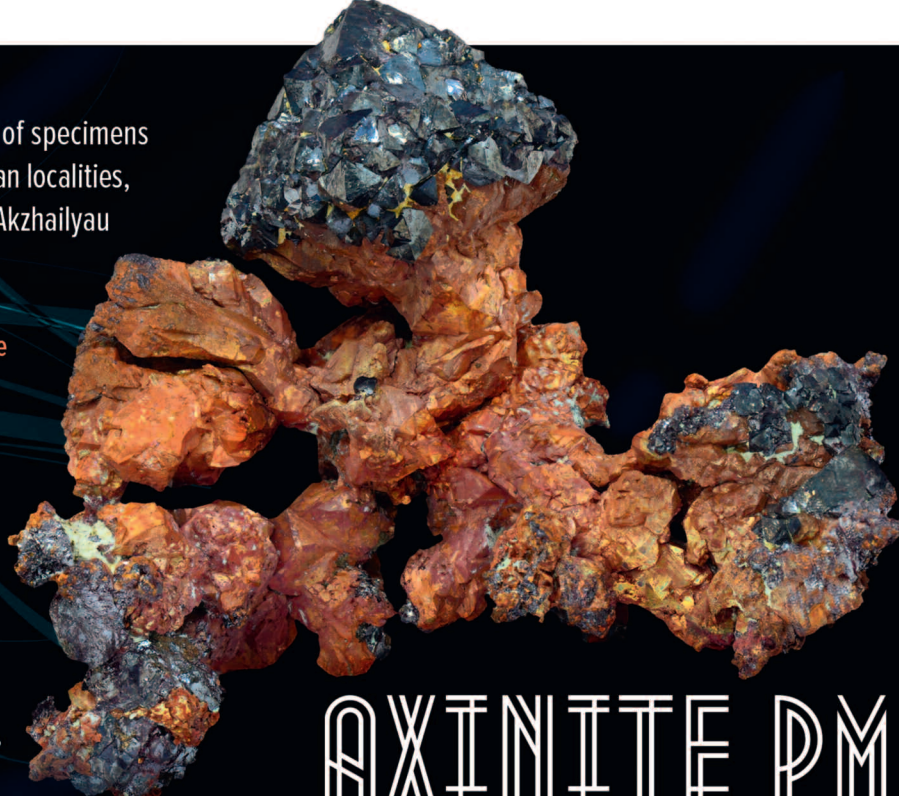

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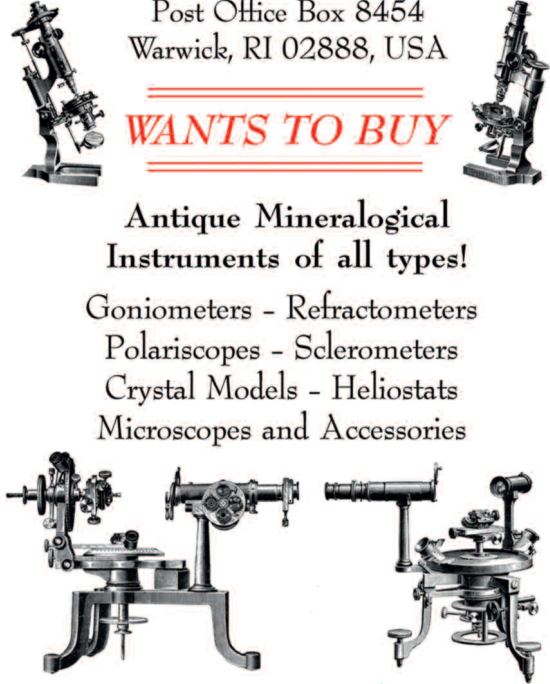
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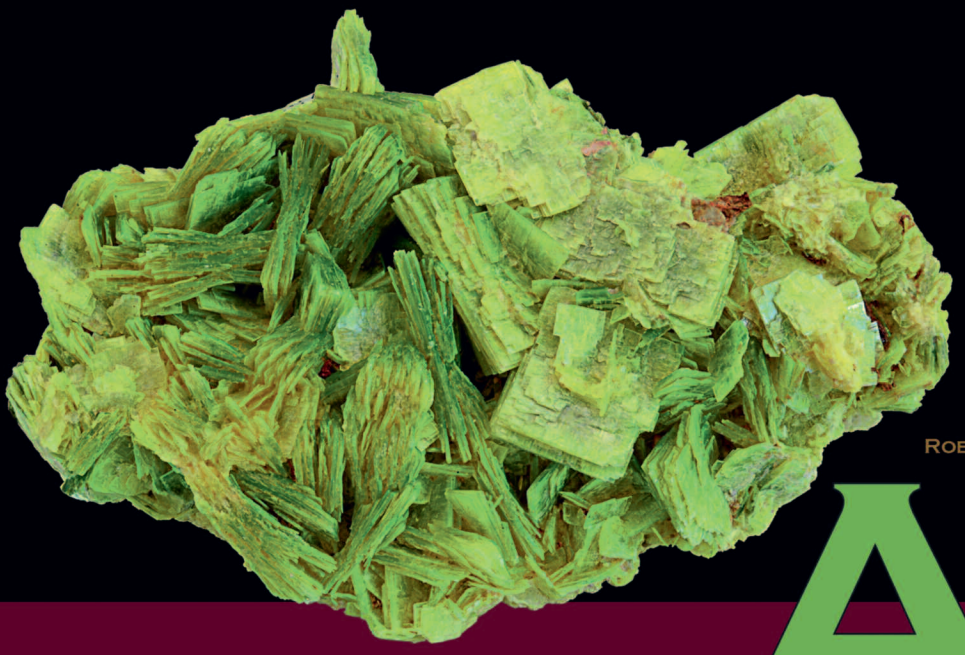
