he 6th International conference "Mineralogical Museums" was held June 17 through 20, 2008 at St. Petersburg State University (SPbSU). The Chair of Mineralogy of Geological faculty organized the meeting. For the sixth time, starting from 1996, curators of museums of Natural Sciences, mineralogists, crystallographers, geologists from Russia and other countries participated in the Conference. The Conference this time was dedicated to the memory of outstanding mineralogist Professor Vladimir F. Barabanov (1918–1997), who was alumni and staff member of the Chair of Mineralogy for a long time. He was a co-founder and the first chairman of the Chair of Geochemistry in SPbSU. Vladimir Fedorovich was also a passionate mineral collector. Thanks to him a lot of specimens from different localities came to the museum collection of the Chair of Mineralogy.
