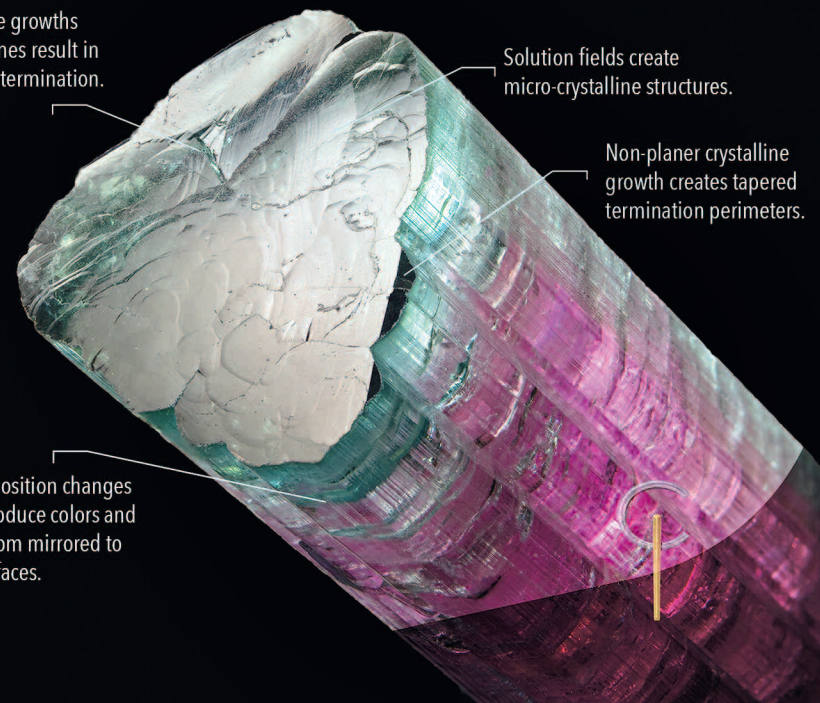
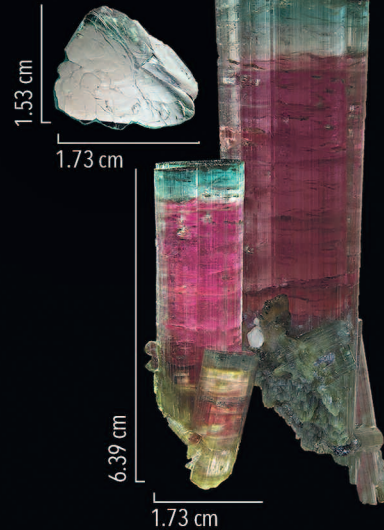
Termination : Radial Scallop C-axis
Inclusion : Trans-axis Healed Fracture

Individual crystalline growths of co-planer termolines result in a stepped elevation termination.

Solution fields create micro-crystalline structures.

Non-planer crystalline growth creates tapered termination perimeters.

Chemical composition changes along C-axis produce colors and terminations from mirrored to translucent surfaces.
